MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

The Club's constitution requires that any person who utilizes the club's facilities (socially or for horse riding) must become a member of the club. Anyone who rides only occasionally, such as a riding school rider who does not have their own horse, and anyone who uses the club's facilities socially, is required to become a social member of the club. Prospective social members have an initial three-month grace period, upon expiry of which they may continue to use the club's facilities only once they have become club members. Should you use the club's riding facilities more than twice a week, or should you purchase your own horse, you will then need to apply for full membership.

Anyone who stables a horse at the club on either a permanent basis, or regularly on a short-term basis must become a full member of KEC. Families and individuals without their own horses may also choose to become full members, and so enjoy the rights and responsibilities which full membership affords: Full members have the right to stand for office, as well as to vote at the Club's Annual General Meeting. At the AGM, family members have one vote per family, and single members have one vote. Furthermore, anyone who has stabled one or more horses at the club for the six months immediately preceding the AGM has one additional vote.

All KEC members also have responsibilities to the club – in particular the responsibility to assist at shows and other fund raising events. Full members are also expected to assist in the day-to-day running of the club.

If you are part of a nuclear family you are required to apply for family membership, and if you are a single adult, you need to apply for single membership. Membership is charged annually and fees paid for the year are not refundable upon cessation of membership.

Upon application, you will receive a copy of the club's constitution and bylaws, which all members are expected to read and abide by. As a member of the Club, you are welcome at the club at any time, and we encourage you especially to come out on the weekends and join in our weekend activities. Weekends are loads of fun, the clubhouse is open while lessons are on the go, and you are encouraged to take the time to come out and watch – and hopefully join in - the weekend fun.

A combination of Lucerne and Teff, or a single fodder, may be fed for supper. Any changes to rations are to be made at the beginning of the month.
